officer's burial

to be tomorrow

Funeral services will be held tomorrow for John J. Coskran, 64, a veteran Minneapolis police officer widely known in the downtown area.

Coskran earned 10 commendations in 23 years of police service, and before he retired in 1963 was downtown precinct sergeant.

Visitation was to begin at 4 p.m. today at Werness Brothers Chapel, 37th St. and Nicollet Av. S., with funeral services at the chapel at 11 a.m. tomorrow. Burial will be in the Ft. Snelling National Cemetery.

Coskran is survived by his widow, Alice, two sons and four grandchildren.
